Fees

Option #1

Student \$450 – Includes instructor fee, all meals, evening snacks & lodging (room or campsite).

Guest (non Student/chaperone) – over 12 - \$305, under 12 - \$155

Option #2

Stay in a campsite and cook your own meals. Student \$300 plus camping fee \$150. This option is cost effective for families.

Schedule

Arrive at Deer Valley Meadows on Sunday, August 18th. Registration begins at 3:00 PM in Dining Hall. Rooms will be assigned based upon registrations. Supper served at 5:30 PM. Everyone will meet in the Auditorium for a Jam and Greet. After the fiddle students have each played a tune of their choice, the instructors will divide the fiddle students into their classes. All students will meet with their instructors about 8:00 PM.

Workshops: Each day students (under 18) are required to attend one of the daily workshops offered by the Instructors.

Concession – A concession will be open for those who wish to purchase snacks during the breaks.

Controlled Jam: Each fiddler, regardless of skill or ability, is invited to play a tune of their choice. Accompanists will give back up and other players will join in. Each person will be limited to one number so that everyone will have an opportunity to perform.

Other jams may be held nightly with levels and locations announced by the Director.

The public is welcome to attend evening performances during the week starting a 7:00 PM.

Thursday - Final Student class concert

Admission to these evening performances is by donation.

Guests for Meals: All extra meals will be paid directly to Deer Valley Meadows. Camp Director will not be taking money. There will be a request form in the dining area.

Name Tags: Please wear your name tag at all times. (Helps the kitchen staff identify who is getting meals)

Dorms/Rooms: For those staying in dorms/rooms, you must supply your own bedding.
