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<u>Workshops</u>: Each day students are required to attend one of the daily workshops offered by the Instructors. <u>Snacks</u>: After the evening activities (around 8:15 - 8:45 pm)

<u>Controlled Jam</u>: Each fiddler, regardless of skill or ability, is invited to play a tune of their choice. Accompanists will give back up and other players will join in. Each person will be limited to one number so that everyone will have an opportunity to perform.

Other jams may be held nightly with levels and locations announced by the Director.

Monday evening we will be treated to performances by the Instructors.

Tuesday evening a Dance will be held.

<u>Wednesday</u> evening will be an <u>open student concert</u> and everybody is encouraged to get in on the act. Plan an individual or group presentation – can be comedy, music of your choice, etc. Instructors do not participate. <u>Thursday</u> : <u>Student Class Concert</u>. The Public is welcome to attend these concerts. There is no cost for attendance but donations toward the Alberta Society of Fiddlers would be greatly appreciated.

<u>Guests for Meals</u>: Should you have any guests who wish to stay for meals, please be sure to advise the Camp Director in advance so that the kitchen staff can be notified. Cost of these meals will be available at Camp.

<u>Name Tags</u>: Please wear your name tag at all times. It identifies you as a camp member, (rather than a guest at meal times) and lets others know the instrument you enjoy playing.

Dorms/Rooms: For those staying in dorms/rooms, you must supply your own bedding.

<u>Camping</u>: Camping sites with electrical hookups are available at no extra cost. The cost of the Camp remains the same- regardless of whether you choose to stay in the dorms or if you wish to take advantage of the camping space. -- Fees are based on the number of guests on the site regardless of where they sleep and/or eat.

-- Those camping have the same access to the dining hall, showers, etc. as those staying in the dorms.

-- Coin operated Laundromat service is available.

<u>Visiting Guests</u>: Any guests wishing to stay overnight who are not registered as part of the camp, must receive prior approval from the Camp Director before arriving. An overnight fee will apply. Visiting guests under the age of eighteen must have chaperone arrangements in place before being allowed to stay.
