ASF Camp Bursary Program

The Alberta Society of Fiddlers has set up a bursary program making funds available for students to help offset the cost to attend the ASF winter and summer fiddle camps.

- 10 bursaries per camp in the amount of \$150 each are available.
- First consideration will be given to applicants 6-18 years old
- Applicants over 18 will be considered only if funds allow.
- Applicant must be a member of the ASF in good standing or their guardian is.

Successful applicants must be able and willing to take on some age appropriate volunteer duties at the camp. Upon completion of the camp, the recipient is requested to provide a brief written description of their camp experience for the ASF newsletter.

How to Apply:

A written letter requesting a bursary must be received at the time of registration.

Applications received prior to April 1st for the ASF August camp and prior to November 1st for the winter He Ho Ha camp, will be given priority. Applications received after the deadline will be processed at the discretion of the Bursary Committee based on funds availability.
