Those under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or chaperone. Chaperone may be an adult attending camp other than an instructor. A.S.F. Camp Policies are in effect at this camp. Please be mindful.

The purpose of this retreat is to provide people an opportunity to enhance their musical abilities. It's <u>NOT</u> <u>INTENDED</u> for raw beginners. A fiddler should be able to play a handful of tunes and piano and guitar players should be able to chord using three chords in three different keys.
